Checks can be mailed to Reading City Hall at 113 S. Main Street, PO Box 240, Reading, MI 49274.

City Utility Payments can also be paid at Century Bank & Trust drive through window as well using the secure envelope slot near the night deposit box, also located at Century Bank & Trust.

Also, Senior Citizens living within the City of Reading can call City Hall and either Chief Stolberg, Sgt. Cooley or any City Employee would be willing to stop by and pick up your payment from your residence.
