AMENDED POLICY

Curb Side Spring Clean-up

Saturday, May 16, 2020

**DUE TO COVID-19 PANDEMIC AND
TO PROMOTE SAFER CONDITIONS FOR ALL,
THE CITY HAS UPDATED CURB SIDE PICK UP RULES**

Curb Side Spring Clean-up: Residents of the City will be able to start placing SOME items at the curb in front of **THEIR address **NO EARLIER THAN Wednesday, May 13th** and nothing should be placed at the curb after **6:00 a.m. on Saturday, May 16th**.**

NO MATTRESSES, UPHOLSTERED FURNITURE, CARPET OR ANY OTHER ITEMS, THAT WHEN WET WILL BECOME HEAVY, AND ARE DIFFICULT FOR THE GARBAGE SERVICE TO PICK UP, PLACED OUTSIDE AT THE CURB ANY SOONER THAN FRIDAY, MAY 15th.

THIS WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED AND ANY RESIDENT NOT IN COMPLIANCE WILL BE REQUIRED TO REMOVE THE ITEMS IMMEDIATELY.

Please continue to follow the COVID-19 guidance issued by the Center for Disease Control (CDC), Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) and the Branch-Hillsdale-St. Joseph Health Department (BHSJ) as well as Governor Whitmer's Executive Order STAY HOME-STAY SAFE-SAVE LIVES to keep the community and the garbage service workers safe.

The Following items are not accepted:

Ashes

Batteries

Burning Barrels

Compost (grass & leaves)

Concrete/bricks

Hazardous Waste

Household garbage (i.e. Food and other materials that can be put out weekly)

Items Containing Freon (refrigerators, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, & freezers)

Liquids (paint, oil, gas, etc.)

Tires

Tree Stumps
