**Ashes**

**Batteries**

**Burning Barrels**

**Compost (grass & leaves)**

**Concrete/bricks**

**Hazardous Waste**

**Household garbage (i.e. Food and other materials that can be put out weekly)**

**Items Containing Freon (refrigerators, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, & freezers)**

**Liquids (paint, oil, gas, etc.)**

**Tires**

**Tree Stumps**
