COVID-19 (CORONAVIRUS) UPDATE- In a continued effort to protect the health and safety of citizens and staff of the City of Reading, and to ensure continuity of municipal services during this pandemic, Reading City Hall will be closed to the public through December 8, 2020.

During this time City Hall will be available by appointment, but this is discouraged and citizens are encouraged to use the telephone, email and payment options as listed below to transact all City business.

City Utility Payments can be paid at Century Bank & Trust drive through window as well using the secure envelope slot near the night deposit box, also located at Century Bank & Trust.

Also, please remember that the City has added a secure drop box located behind City Hall to the Southside of the middle door. Utility payments as well as 2020 Property Tax Payments, zoning permit applications, etc., can be dropped in this secure drop box at any time.
