A meeting of the City of Reading Election Commission was called to order at 9:00 a.m. Present were Mayor Melani Matthews, City Manager/Clerk/Treasurer Kimberly Blythe and absent was City Attorney Tom Thompson.

A motion was made by Matthews and supported by Blythe to appoint Charity Willoughby (Dem), Geraldine Kerspilo (Rep), April Jepson (Rep), Cheryl King (Dem), Chairperson; Pamela Rosenberry, (Rep), Samuel Blythe, (Dem), Anthony Willoughby, (Rep) and Roger Wheeler (Rep) as regular precinct election inspectors for the August 2, 2022, Primary Election. A motion was made by Blythe and supported by Matthews to conduct a Public Accuracy Test on Thursday, July 14, 2022 at 10:00 am in the City Hall for the August 2, 2022 Primary Election. This motion carried 2-0

A preliminary accuracy test will be conducted prior to the public accuracy test on both the Tabulator and the VAT (Voter Assist Terminal).

A motion was made by Blythe and supported by Matthews to appoint Geraldine Kerspilo (Republican) and Cheryl King (Democrat) to the City of Reading Receiving Board for the August 2, 2022 Primary Election. This motion carried 2-0

A motion was made by Matthews and supported by Blythe to appoint Charity Willoughby (Dem), April Jepson (Rep) as Closing Inspectors for the August 2, 2022 Election. This motion carried 2-0

A motion was made by Matthews and supported by Blythe to authorize the Clerk to take other actions as necessary to conduct the August 2, 2022 Primary Election. This motion carried 2-0
