MEETING CALLED TO ORDER BY MAYOR MATTHEWS AT 6:30 P.M. PLEDGE TO ALLEGIANCE

ROLL CALL: Matthews, George, VanCamp and Penney, Chief Stolberg and Kimberly Blythe, City Manager/Clerk/Treasurer all present.

FIRST CALL TO THE PUBLIC

Mark Wiley, County Commissioner was in attendance to give an update on the Commissioners latest meeting. He shared that Michigan Works reported that Hillsdale County's unemployment rate is lower than this time in 2023, that MSUE gave an update on the bird flu and how it could affect County fairs for 2024 but feel that it should not be an issue for Hillsdale County Fair. Mr. Wiley mentioned sending a flyer regarding the proposal for the 800 MHz Radio Project and millage proposal as well as the Medical Care Facility and Emergency will have millage proposals on the ballot as well.

Public Hearing-2024/2025 Budget/Millage/Rate Schedules

Mayor Matthews called the public hearing to order at 6:45pm. The hearing is regarding the FY 2024/2025 Budget; citizens had the opportunity to ask questions regarding the upcoming budget and proposed expenditures and estimated revenues. Also, as part of the budget process the water, sewer and refuse rate schedules were discussed. There is a requirement by USDA to increase the water rates for an expected revenue based on the estimated loan value for the MELS Project. There are also minimal increases for sewer and refuse. There was discussion of the 2024 tax millage rate of 12.3206, which is lower than last year, due to an increase in the 2024 Taxable Value of the City, the Headlee Rollback, and Truth in Taxation. -Penney moved, George seconded to approve the recommendation from MT Engineering that Meade Brothers Excavating, Inc., be awarded the project, subject to USDA-RD, MEDC and MDOT review and approval.

Meade Brothers Excavating, LLC submitted a construction bid in the amount of \$4,097,532.56 that included both the cost for all construction within the right of way as well as the replacement of private service lines from the curb stop to eighteen inches within inside the home.

The City Attorney sent over the amendments to the ordinance, Council reviewed them and after discussion regarding the amendments, there were questions regarding some of the verbiage in the amended ordinance. It was the consensus of the Council to table it until July's Meeting.
