NOTICE OF ADOPTION

ORDINANCE #2024-01

CITY OF READING – ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 2017-01 OF THE CITY OF READING, AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 2017-02, ORDINANCE NO. 2018-02, AND ORDINANCE NO. 2019-01, TO AMEND SUBSECTION 1 OF SECTION III OF THE ORDINANCE, AS AMENDED, TO CHANGE THE MAXIMUM POTENTIAL NUMBER OF MEDICAL MARIHUANA PROVISIONING CENTERS THAT MAY BE AUTHORIZED BY THE CITY.

Notice is hereby given that the Reading City Council adopted an ordinance titled, “[a]n Ordinance to amend Ordinance No. 2017-01 of the City of Reading, as amended by Ordinance No. 2017-02, Ordinance No. 2018-02, and Ordinance No. 2019-01, to amend Subsection 1 of Section III of the Ordinance, as amended, to change the maximum potential number of medical marihuana provisioning centers that may be authorized by the City.”

Summary of Ordinance

The ordinance amends the potential number of medical marihuana provisioning center licenses that may be granted in the City under the City’s Medical Marihuana Facilities Ordinance from three (3) to five (5), subject to a cap on the total number of combined medical marihuana provisioning center licenses and marihuana retailer licenses issued by the City under its Marihuana Establishments Ordinance of five (5) total locations with provisioning center and/or retailer licenses.

The Ordinance shall take effect on August 16, 2024, said being at least ten days from the date of publication of this Notice of Adoption.
