CITY OF READING – AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 2019-02 OF THE CITY OF READING TO AMEND SUBSECTION 1c OF SECTION III OF THE ORDINANCE TO CHANGE THE MAXIMUM POTENTIAL NUMBER OF MARIHUANA RETAILERS THAT MAY BE AUTHORIZED BY THE CITY.

Notice is hereby given that the Reading City Council adopted an ordinance titled, "[a]n Ordinance to amend Ordinance 2019-02 to amend Subsection 1c of Section III of the Ordinance to change the maximum potential number of marihuana retailers that may be authorized by the City."

Summary of Ordinance

The ordinance amends the potential number of marihuana retailer licenses that may be granted in the City under the City's Marihuana Establishments Ordinance from three (3) to five (5), subject to a cap on the total number of combined marihuana retailer licenses and medical marihuana provisioning center licenses issued by the City under its Medical Marihuana Facilities Ordinance of five (5) total locations with provisioning center and/or retailer licenses.

The Ordinance shall take effect ten (10) days from the date of publication of this Notice of Adoption.
