The meeting was called to order by chair, Chuck Hartshorn, at 6:31 PM at Reading City Hall. Present were Chuck Hartshorn, Melani Matthews, Adrien Miller, Frank Oddou, and Chad Penney. Absent was Warren Bartles. Also present were Ben Wheeler and Hannah Tunis.

Adrien mentioned that some of the links in the agenda didn't open for her - it's most likely firewalls on her end that prevent them from opening.

OLD BUSINESS: Redevelopment Ready Communities; no updates. Chuck asked Ben to send him an email early in the week to remind him to review.

NEW BUSINESS: We have two applications to review from people desiring to fill the empty seat on the Planning Commission and TIFA boards. Stewart Matz and Hannah Tunis each submitted an application. After review of the applications, Chad made a motion, seconded by Adrien, to recommend Hannah Tunis be appointed by the City Council to serve on the Planning Commission and TIFA Boards. Motion carried 5-0.
