MELS (Michigan/East/Lynn/Strong) Project Updates

Two impromptu construction meetings were held to determine relocating the watermain on Michigan Street from where it was originally proposed in the engineering plans and it was decided to place the watermain under Michigan Street as opposed to in the terrace between the curb and sidewalk due to so many obstacles being in the way.

B. City Hall Bathroom & Storage Room Renovations

-Crank moved, Gary seconded to approve the quote from Home Depot for the Renovations of the storage area, which includes painting, flooring, as well as creating a larger double door opening into the storage area for better access, in the amount of \$13,963.61 and to table the quote and work for the bathroom. The quote for the bathroom was tabled.

There was considerable discussion regarding the quotes and associated costs for the proposed services. Council members were informed that it is often difficult to find individuals or contractors willing to both conduct a site visit and subsequently submit a formal quote. The lack of architectural or engineered specifications further complicates the process, making it challenging to compare bids accurately or evaluate them on a consistent basis. Some individuals compared the project to personal experiences with do-it-yourself bathroom renovations and cost. City staff will continue to explore alternative options for completing the necessary renovations and maintenance at City Hall.

C. Exterior Doors for City Hall Complex:

No action/discussion as we did not receive an updated quote for the replacements and upgrades as needed.

D. Proclamation – Autism Acceptance Month
