Main Street, Reading, Michigan 49274, for the purpose of receiving public comment on the proposed vacation of the entirety of Second Street as dedicated in the Plat of Thomas' Addition to the Village, now City, of Reading, as recorded in Liber 7 of Plats, Page 10, Hillsdale County Records.

The portion of Second Street under consideration has never been improved, developed, or maintained for public use. The proposed vacation is being considered pursuant to Section 7.10(b) of the City Charter of the City of Reading and Section 257 of the Michigan Land Division Act (MCL 560.257).

The public is invited and encouraged to attend this public hearing.
