CITY OF READING NOTICE OF ADOPTION

ORDINANCE #2021-01

CITY OF READING – ORDINANCE PROHIBITING OVERNIGHT PARKING ON RESIDENTIAL STREETS AND AUTHORIZING CITY PERSONNEL OTHER THAN POLICE OFFICERS TO ISSUE PARKING CITATIONS

Notice is hereby given that the Reading City Council adopted an ordinance titled, “An Ordinance to prohibit overnight parking on residential streets within the City of Reading, and to authorize city personnel other than police officers to issue parking citations.”

Summary of Ordinance

The ordinance provides that it is unlawful for any person to park or suffer the parking of any vehicle, trailer, or other object on any residential street within the City of Reading at any time between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m. The ordinance further authorizes, pursuant to MCL 257.742(6), that in addition to City police officers, the City Manager, Maintenance Supervisor, Deputy Clerk/Treasurer, and the Code Enforcement Official may issue and serve a citation for the violation of any City ordinance involving the parking or standing of a motor vehicle within the City.

This Ordinance shall take effect ten (10) days from the publication of this Notice of Adoption.

A copy of the Ordinance may be inspected at Reading City Hall, 113 S. Main Street, Reading, Michigan 49274 between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m. and 1:00 p.m. and 5:00 p.m., Monday through Thursday and may be viewed on the City’s website at www.reading.mi.us.
