FALL LEAF COLLECTION SCHEDULE

November 3 – November 25, 2015

The Reading Department of Public Works will be collecting leaves from all city streets. Please reference the chart for collection days and please use the following guidelines. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated and is essential for the leaf collection process to be successful. If you have questions, don't hesitate to call City Hall at 283-2604.

- Residents may rake loose leaves to the curb or shoulder of the road no earlier than the Friday evening before the assigned collection date. Do not place leaves in the street, as this may cause blockage and/or other problems with the storm sewer system. Each property owner will be responsible for the immediate removal of any/all leaves placed along the street before and/or after the designated time.
- Please separate brush and twigs from the leaves since they can cause damage to the leaf vacuum.
- No bagged yard waste will be collected after October 23, 2015 if you bag your leaves after this date you will need to haul the bags to the Department of Public Works office located at 180 W. Lincoln St. and place them in an orderly fashion on the cement slab located north of the DPW office.
- In the event of an early snowfall, leaf collection will continue after the snow has been cleared, however, our collection may be a day or two behind schedule.
- Please do not park in the street on your assigned collection days.
- The public works department has the right to refuse pick-up of any leaves.
